

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


4. Did you **encounter any problems**? For example, misunderstandings, work distribution, lack of trust, etc.




Virtual Exchange is...



...a form of computer-mediated learning whereby **students from geographically remote classes work together online** (in pairs or small groups) on learning tasks developed by teachers or educational facilitators.






What are the aims of involving our students in a VE?

1. language skills
2. intercultural communicative competence
3. digital literacies and transversal 21st century skills
4. international perspectives on the course topic
5. ...

continuous exchange, comparison between countries and reflection on intercultural learning experience



Steps for Designing a class-to-class VE

1. Preliminary Steps:

Finding a partner and minimum common ground

2. Development:

- Shared or complementary learning outcomes.
- Designing activities
- Mode and tools of interaction
- Integration of VE in the syllabus (Course LO, Evaluation)

3. Implementation - monitoring & supervision of students, reflection throughout the project.


4. Assessment

Key principle:


Reciprocity and autonomy

(Little and Brammerts, 1996)




In each phase:

- Which **tools** can be used in VE?
- Mode of communication: **Synchronous or Asynchronous?**

Class 1: Advanced Web Design

- 22 students in Uppsala
- 2nd year BA Media studies
- 1st semester September - December

Class 2: Business and ethics

- 20 students in Groningen
- 2nd year International Business
- 1st semester September - December
