

Privacystatement YoungRUG

The University of Groningen (RUG) always handles your personal data with care; you must be able to trust that they will be processed lawfully and protected appropriately. The RUG therefore wants to be transparent about what it does with your personal data. The policy for this is included in the document: [General policy on protection of personal data](#). This statement informs you about how the RUG processes your data and what rights you have.



Purpose of processing personal data:

YoungRUG is a community for young support staff of the RUG. The focus is on professional development, networking and the exchange of knowledge.



Source document and retention periods:

Data is provided by members themselves and deleted 5 years after unsubscribing. Of alumni, only first and last names are kept.



In which systems do we store your data:

Your data will be kept in other systems namely: Google-sheet.



Recipients of your personal data:

Your data will be shared within the RUG with authorized staff such as active members, board and student assistant.



Principles underlying the processing of data:

Agreement



Your rights:

- Right to ask for an overview/removal or to be rectified of the personal data collected on you
- Right to data portability (data transfers)
- Right to restrict processing
- Right to object to the processing of your data



Categories of personal data:

- SalutationAanhef
- Name and address details
- Contact details
- Other, namely: photos of events and any dietary requirements
