General Terms and Conditions for the Online course

Sustainability Assurance (ISSA 5000)

1. You, hereinafter referred to as the client, register for a study programme, course or other form of education, hereinafter referred to as a course, by means of a fully completed and signed registration form or quotation.
2. The University of Groningen, hereinafter referred to as the contractor, will determine upon registration whether admission has been granted and will confirm this in writing to each participant.
3. The start date of a course is determined by the contractor.
4. The stated prices include study materials as well as access to excursions and exclude literature, travel and accommodation costs, unless indicated otherwise by the contractor for specific courses.
5. Participants/clients must have made their payment before the start of the course, no later than 30 days after receipt of the invoice. If the payment term of the invoice is exceeded, the contractor reserves the right to deny the participant access to the course and not to issue the final certificate or diploma as long as the invoice has not been paid in full.
6. If a course or part thereof is not completed within the relevant study duration, the program management determines the period of validity of the (partial) study results obtained. Possible re-registration is possible against payment of a surcharge, provided that the course is still available in the same form.
7. In the event of unforeseen circumstances, the contractor reserves the right to adjust the course dates, adjust the format or cancel the course, for example in the event of insufficient registrations. In serious cases where continuation of the course is not feasible, it will be canceled by the contractor free of charge without any compensation.
8. If the client wishes to cancel the registration, this can be done in writing prior to the start date under the following conditions:
 - Cancellation at least 12 weeks before the start of the course: 75% refund.
 - Cancellation between 12 and 4 weeks before the start of the course: 25% refund.
 - Cancellation less than 4 weeks before the start of the course: no refund.Up to 4 weeks before the start of the course, a cooling-off period of 2 weeks after registration applies.
9. The contractor is the owner of the intellectual property rights, including but not limited to copyright and trademark rights, in respect of all study materials developed by the contractor and its lecturers. These are exclusively intended for personal practice, study or non-commercial use of the client of the relevant course. It is not permitted to reproduce, publish or change such a course product without the prior consent of the contractor. The client is also not permitted, on the basis of the original concept developed by the contractor, with regard to the developed course and the developed course materials, itself or in collaboration with third parties, to take over in the broadest sense of the word without the prior written permission of the contractor.

10. The University of Groningen makes every effort to offer the client a high-quality course, both in terms of content and organisation, in accordance with current standards. In the event of irreparable, incorrect, incomplete information or other defects, the contractor is only liable for direct damage suffered up to a maximum of the costs of the course paid by the client. Unless there is intent or gross negligence, the contractor is not liable for indirect damage such as consequential damage, lost profit, missed savings, consequences of failure, or not completing the course on time. In the event of an attributable shortcoming, the client must immediately inform the contractor of this in writing and it is not possible to suspend or set off the payment obligation.
11. By signing a registration form or quotation, the client/participant confirms that these terms and conditions are known and accepted. Changes and/or additions are only possible if they have been agreed in writing. This agreement is exclusively governed by Dutch law. Any disputes can be submitted to the competent court of the District Court of the Northern Netherlands.
