Austria:

Exemption when English course is part of school examination (Prüfungsgebiet der Reifeprüfung).

- *Mentioned separately on grade list.*

Belgium:

Exemption when English course is part of school examination (usually indicated by abbreviation: 'EX' on transcript).

Denmark:

Exemption when English course is in curriculum (on transcript).

Estonia:

Exemption when English course is part of state examination (Riigieksamid). Examination subjects are mentioned on separate state examination certificate: the Riigieksamitunnistus.

Disclaimer: B2 niveau moet worden behaald.

Finland:

Exemption when English course 'Englannin' (A or B1) is part of national matriculation examination (Ylioppilastutkinto/ Studentexamen). Examination subjects are mentioned on the frontside of the final diploma certificate.

France:

Option Internationale du Baccalauréat is the international stream of the Diplôme du Baccalauréat General. Exemption is only possible when the applicant has followed the British stream (Section Britannique / Section Anglais).

Germany:

Exemption when English course is part of school examination (Prüfungsfach). Either as Leistungskurs or Grundkurs. Exemption is also possible when English course is not examination subject but still Leistungskurs. Aforementioned courses can be indicated by the following abbreviations in transcript (depending on Bundesland):

- *PF, LK or eA.*

Hungary:

Exemption when English course 'Angol' is part of school matura examination (Érettségi vizsga).

Latvia:

Exemption when English course 'Angļu valodā' is part of national examination (Centralizētais eksāmens).

Lithuania:

Exemption when English course 'Užsienio kalba (Anglų)' is part of final state matura examination (Brandos Egzamino).

Luxembourg:

English course is mandatory part of final examination, regardless of profile/stream followed.

Norway:

Exemption when either English course 'SPR3010' or 'SPR3012' is in curriculum (on transcript).

- *SPR3010 (Samfunnsfaglig engelsk, skriftlig = English for social sciences, written)*
- *SPR3012 (Engelskspråklig litteratur og kultur, skriftlig = English lit. & culture, written)*

Romania:

Exemption when English course 'Limba Engleză' is part of national examination (Examenul de Bacalaureat).

Examination subjects are mentioned on the backside of the final Diplomă de Bacalaureat certificate.

Slovakia:

Exemption when English course 'Anglický jazyk' is part of Maturita examination. The Maturita examination consists of an internally-assessed, and an externally-assessed component. (The English course include both the internal and external examination).

Sweden:

Exemption when all the following subjects are in curriculum (on transcript):

- *English 5*
- *English 6*
- *English 7*
