# Beschrijving colleges

## **Psychology of Religion**

*Religious motivation: Why are people religious?*

In this class we are going to explore some of the explanations psychologists have offered for why people do or do not feel attracted to religion or spirituality.

We are going to look at explanations by the famous classical psychologists Sigmund Freud and William James, but also by the newer approaches in psychology of personality theory and cognitive neuroscience.

We will relate this to our own religious motivation

*Een korte introductie*

Deze les geeft een inleiding in Hebreeuws. Het vak Hebreeuws is een belangrijk onderdeel van de studie Theologie. Zeker in het eerste jaar is dit vak een groot onderdeel van het curriculum.

## **Religion, Diversity and Identity (ENG)**

*Religion and sexuality: reflections on politics and everyday life*

How religion and sexuality are related is a highly charged topic in political and public debates. Discussions on the sexual assaults in Cologne on New Year's Eve 2015, the Burkini Ban on the beaches in France in 2016 as well as the issue of gay rights and religious norms regarding homosexuality are frequently focus of heated debates in the Netherlands, Europe and beyond. As researchers on religion we are interested in understanding the complex relations between religion and sexuality, and reflect on how these public controversies relate to the everyday meanings of religion and sexuality. This workshop will demonstrate how the social scientific study of religion allows us to analyse such complex cases in the broader context in which they take place. We will explore empirical examples from various parts of the world, including the Netherlands and Uganda.

## **Praktische Theologie (NL)**

*"Kerkgangers zijn sociale kapitalisten"*

## **Sociology of Religion (ENG)**

*"Religion is the Opium of the People"*

In this lecture we will explore what Marx meant when he made his famous statement that 'religion is the opium of the people'. Was he anti-religious? Did he want to banish religion like we want to banish drug-addiction nowadays? How do his arguments concerning religion play a role in present-day attitudes towards religion?

## **Islam: History, Sources and Practices (ENG)**

*Reading the Qur'ān*

Is Arabic or faith more important in reading the Qur'ān? This class will provide a brief overview of the contents and structure of the Qur'ān. Students will be introduced to different narratives that are found in the Qur'ān, and to various ways of reading them. These readings will cover both traditional Islamic narratives about the Qur'ān, as well as some classical and modern criticisms of these approaches.
