



Regulation Faculty Heritage Committee

Approved by the Faculty Board on 22 June 2017.

Task

The Faculty Heritage Committee has the following tasks:

- › to develop proposals for the archiving of visual material (photos, film and audio material) related to the faculty.
- › to develop proposals for archiving written material relating to the faculty.
- › to develop proposals for recording the oral history of the faculty, for example, interviews with emeriti or other persons who have knowledge of the history of the faculty.
- › directing the archiving of all material.
- › advising the Faculty Board on making the faculty heritage visible.
- › raising the awareness of BSS's cultural heritage in education.

Composition

The Faculty Heritage Committee consists of at least 4 members affiliated with the Faculty of Behavioural and Social Sciences. All departments are, in principle, represented in the Committee. The Committee could be supplemented with external members.

Appointment

- › The Committee, itself, chooses a chairman from among its members.
- › The chairman and all members are appointed by the Faculty Board.
- › The members are appointed for a term of five years and are eligible for reappointment.

Frequency of meeting

The working group meets at least three times a year.

Explanatory note

The tasks of the Faculty Heritage Committee are partly linked to the Archive and Documentation Centre for Dutch Behavioural Sciences that is housed within the faculty. The Faculty Heritage Committee directs the faculty project; it initiates and realizes the heritage room. The responsibility for the management of the heritage room, lies with the ADNG.

Support

The Committee is being supported by an official secretary from SAS.
