Spotlight

Dr. Georgian Nedelcu

Zernike Institute for Advanced Materials

What do you currently work on?

I started in October 2020 as a researcher/postdoc in the Materials Chemistry group with Prof. Loredana Protesescu. In May 2022, I became the funding officer for ZIAM. I initially learned about this position through the RUG internal openings webpage and once the COVID restrictions started to ease up, I started networking and letting other people know about my intentions. In this position, I identify grant opportunities within the Horizon Europe programme, especially Pillars II and III, and support researchers throughout the application process. It might not sound very exciting, but in fact, it's more complicated and entertaining than it might seem because I must keep in mind the very broad and generous distinctive research interests of over 40 PIs.

What do you do in your spare time?

I'm still educating myself on the notion of "spare time." I didn't really have much spare time as a PhD and researcher...but now that I have more normal working hours, I'm going a bit more often to the gym or catching up with friends over a drink, or just enjoying some lazy time on the sofa with some Netflix. It was very fulfilling to have been part of the PostDoc Council, to know people, and to organize events for my fellow colleagues. I must admit that I'm quite proud of the Career Chat that I started with Meagan, Xiangcheng, and Lyes, and still goes on successfully.

What is one thing you wished you knew before starting a postdoc?

I don't think there's something in particular. In principle, I knew pretty much everything was possible before accepting the offer of coming here. However, I consider it very important to know all the opportunities and facilities offered by the university.
