Transcript of Records

Note for scholarship registrars: the period of registration mentioned in the Transcript of records is an administrative registration period and may differ from the actual exchange period.

ECTS Credit system

ECTS is the official Dutch credit system. 60 ECTS credits represent the workload of a full-time student in one academic year. One credit represents 28 student working hours according to the Dutch law on Higher Education. Student working hours include class hours, reading, independent studies, preparation for examinations, etc.

Grading

The Transcript of Records includes the official Dutch grading scale. In addition to the host institution's actual grade the ECTS grading scale ranks the students on a statistical basis. The ECTS grade is based on the relative performance of the student compared to other students who have passed the examination. In ECTS the grade A stands for the best 10% of successful students.

Dutch grading practice

The Dutch grading scale runs from 10 (highest mark) to 1 (lowest mark). The grade 5,5 is the pass grade, while an 8 is considered very good indeed. A 9, let alone a 10 are rarely given. Most students are awarded a 6 or a 7.
