

Transition Regulation termination LLM International Business Law

Introduction

Due to a too low intake number for the LLM International Business Law, the Faculty had decided to terminate this programme per September 2020. Effectively no new intake will take place per 1 September 2019. Some courses are also part of other LLM programmes and thus will be offered as regular courses in the academic year 2019-2020, others will be offered in alternative modes.

Students have to have successfully passed all compulsory courses and have obtained the minimum of 60 ECTS before 31 August 2020 in order to graduate from the LLM programme International Business Law.
