

Transition Regulation LLB International and European Law – first year

Introduction

The set-up of the first year of the LLB programme International and European Law will change per the academic year 2025/26.

The course Law and Legal Skills: IT for Lawyers and the course Legal and Academic English will be merged into one course per 1 September 2025. This new course will be called Introduction to Legal English and Research Skills.

Transition Regulation

Students who have started the LLB programme International and European Law **before 1 September 2025** and who have:

- not passed the course *Legal and Academic English* will have to take the new *Introduction to Legal English and Research Skills* after 1 September 2025;
- passed Law and *Legal Skills: the Dutch example* **but have not passed** the course *Law and Legal Skills: IT for Lawyers* will have to repeat the *Law and Legal Skills: IT for Lawyers* part. This part will be offered in 2025/26 as a directed reading course for one more year;
- not passed either parts *Law and Legal Skills: the Dutch example* **and** *Law and Legal Skills: IT for Lawyers* will have to pass the adjusted course *Law and Legal Skills: the Dutch example* per 1 September 2025.

Students can still complete the LLB programme International and European Law, including the Technology Law track, with the course *Law and Legal Skills: IT for Lawyers* and the course *Legal and Academic English* until 1 September 2030.

Applicability

This regulation is applicable to all students in the LLB programme International and European Law who have started the programme **on or before** the academic year 2024/25.
