



Verhulst Award jubilee symposium

'GOLDEN YOUTH'

50 child- and adolescent year psychiatry/ psychology

We invite all early career researchers to apply for the Verhulst Award. As from 2020, the Verhulst Award of € 1,500 will be granted biannually upon an outstanding young researcher who published a paper with a substantial contribution to the field of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry. The aim of the Verhulst Award is to promote the academic development of talented young researchers, e.g., by enabling a visit to a university abroad or attending an international conference or course. The Award is open to all academic disciplines working in the field of child and adolescent psychiatry.

The Verhulst Award Committee, consisting of national and international experts in the field of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry, will review the applications. The Verhulst Award Committee consists of Prof. em. Frank Verhulst, Prof. em. Hans Ormel, and Prof. Nadia Micali. If we receive more than 15 applications, an internal committee from the Erasmus MC department of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry/Psychology (Dr. Esther Mesman, Prof. Pauline Jansen, Prof. Neeltje van Haren) will perform a first selection.

Candidates can apply when they are a PhD student or a post-doc (<2 years since PhD), or equivalent, at a Dutch university at January 1 2020.

Submission requirements:

- 1) a first author publication, published (or Epub ahead of print) between January 1 2018 and December 31 2019;
- 2) a motivation on how the publication contributes to the field of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and a description of the role of the candidate (max 300 words);
- 3) a proposal on how the award will be spent (max 100 words);
- 4) a letter of reference from a senior researcher

Deadline for applications: January 10 2020

The application form and attachments can be sent to verhulstaward.kjpp@erasmusmc.nl. The candidates will receive a confirmation email shortly after submitting the application.

All candidates will be informed at the end of February 2020.

The winner is invited to present his/her work at our symposium "Golden Youth" on March 13, 2020.
