7.2 Graduate students

Graduate students and postdocs are responsible for a good deal of the day-to-day work of CLCG, including the organization of the meetings of the research groups, the organization of the CLCG colloquia, the organization of the CLCG Linguistics Lunches, the publishing of the weekly CLCG calendar, and the organization of the annual CLCG TABU Dag.
