News from the Institutes	
Engineering and Technology Institute Groningen (ENTEG)	In an outstanding collaboration, Prof. Erik Heeres from the Engineering and Technology Institute Groningen (ENTEG) is set to play a pivotal role in an innovative project alongside industrial partner BioBTX . Together with partners from the Technical University of Eindhoven, this consortium has successfully secured a substantial Just Transition Fund (JTF) subsidy of €2.8 million.
Groningen Biomolecular Sciences and Biotechnology (GBB) Stratingh Institute for Chemistry Zernike Institute for Advanced Materials (ZIAM)	 The European Research Council has awarded three Synergy Grants to researchers at the Faculty of Science and Engineering (FSE): Prof. Dirk Slotboom (GBB) receives a grant of EUR 2.1 million for the project 'GRAIL': GRAIL - Time-resolved imaging of membrane transporter dynamics under physiological ionic gradients. Prof. Sijbren Otto (Stratingh) receives a grant of EUR 3.4 million for the project 'MINILIFE' - Making life as we don't know it yet Prof. Elisabetta Chicca (Zernike) CogniGron receives a grant of EUR 2.7 million for the project 'SWIMS' - Transforming IoT Sensory
Groningen Institute for Evolutionary Life Sciences (GELIFES)	 Systems for a Sustainable Future. There are currently three open tenure track positions in Behavioural Neuroscience, in Ecological Genomics and in Wadden Sea Ecology!
