First, let me introduce myself: my name is Aafke Engwerda. I am a second-year Dutch medical student and I will be assisting Barbara in analysing the data on the chromosome 6 aberrations. I will focus on the proximal 6q deletions (6q11-q16). I will start work on the data in July and we hope to report our results to you in September.
