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Field

- Choose panel wisely: who's in panel? what/who have they funded?
- Study panelists' websites. Read summaries awarded grants

Grand challenge(s) in the field

Their grand challenge. Not yours.

Scientific state(s) of the art

Show you know their literature, trends, views.

Scientific bottleneck

– Why hasn't it been tackled yet?

Your novel iSolution

- Why this, why now. Pilot evidence needed.
- Whitepaper/perspectives, track record in iScience

Your proposal (text)

- Use their language. Keep it SIMPLE. Both for non-expert and expert.
- Beware: you are a threat to mainstream people; you step on their shoulders
- Be concrete on tasks to convince reviewers from your own discipline(s).

Impact if project ends successfully

Field and problem changed substantially? Again: from their perspective.

Use other people: FFO, TD, sparring partners, grantees, ex-panelists
