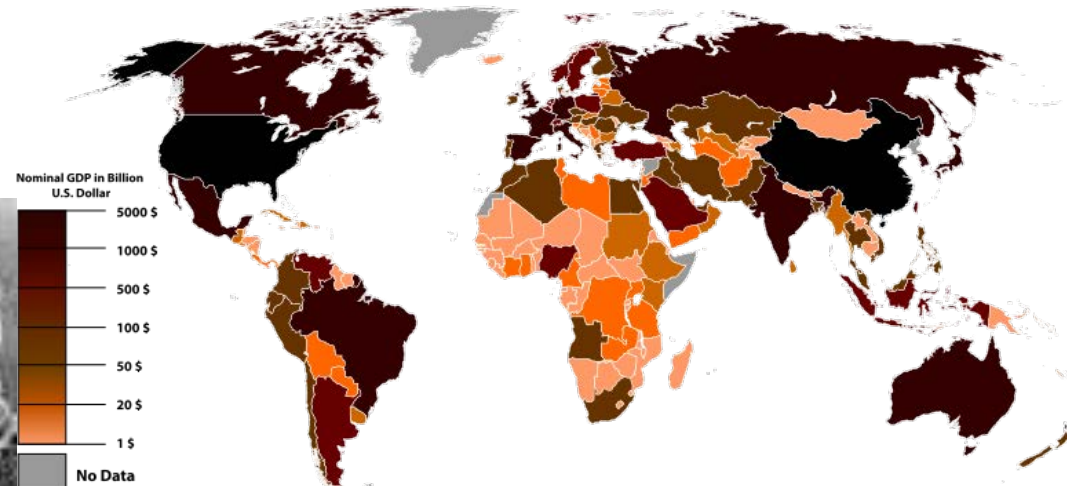

- Many societal problems require a **political solution**, have an important **economic** dimension, and pose us for **ethical** dilemmas.
- Focuses on **institutions** that are crucial to how **societies function**
- **Economics** and **political** science looks at how these **work** and what **incentives** they provide
- **Philosophy** addresses what **roles** institutions play in society and how the state should **treat** its citizens



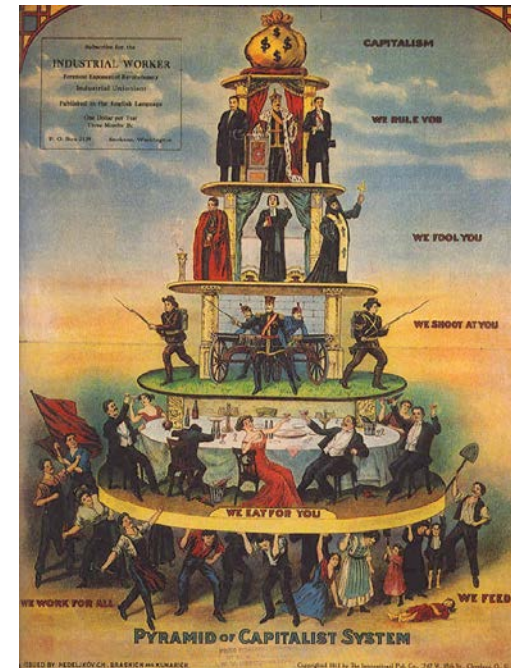
PPE major 1st year

PPE major year 2

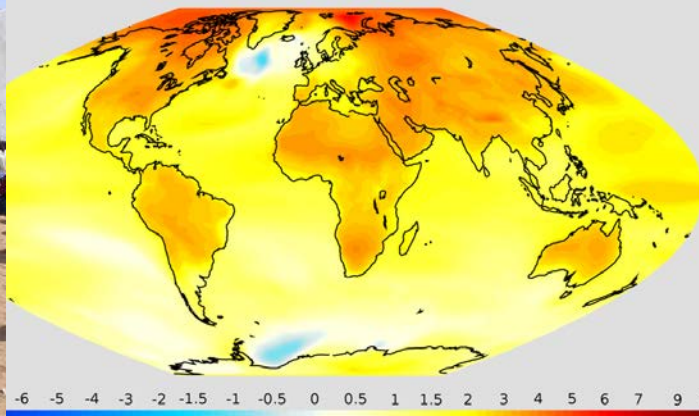
- Mandatory courses within UCG (15 EC):

- Minor (30 EC)

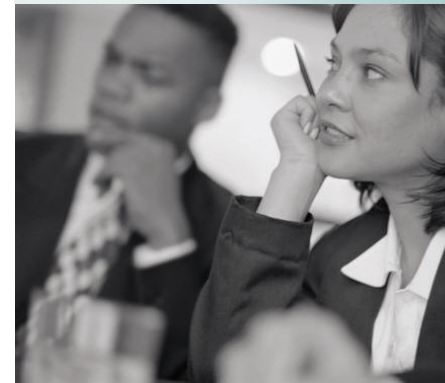




PPE Masters programme
